## Basket and 50/50 Raffles and Silent Auction Information

In order to make the Assembly a success, we are asking that every group in the Region that is able contribute to the Basket Raffle or Silent Auction. Information for these items follow:

**Silent Auction** – If someone in your group is artistically talented, we would love to have an item that can displayed and allow attendees to bid on the item. Examples would include artwork, needlepoint, book covers, woodwork, etc. You could have someone bring it to the Assembly or send it to Rod S. at the address below.

**Basket Raffle** – Every year we have many baskets that will be raffled at the end of the day. Your group could have a couple members make up a basket to be included. (Generally speaking, groups will spend from approximately \$30 to \$70 on a basket.) Examples of basket themes in the past:

- BBQ rubs and/or sauces from your area
- Home Improvement tools, national chain box store gift card
- Movie Night Red Box gift card, microwavable popcorn, soda, candy
- Coffee Starbucks gift card, coffee mugs, flavorings etc.
- Dinner Out gift card to a national chain with menu
- Shopping gift card to a national chain store
- Serenity, Meditation or Relaxation CDs, DVDs, books, candles, neck pillow
- Gardening tools, flower or vegetable seeds, gardening book
- Nar-Anon Literature various pieces of Nar-Anon Literature

If no one from your group will be attending the Assembly, gift cards and smaller items can be sent to Rod S. to be included in the Raffle. Another possibility, you could make a donation in lieu of a basket and send a check to Rod S.

**50/50 Raffle** – Raffle tickets will be sold during the day for this raffle. The total amount collected will be split between the winner of the raffle and the Midwest Region.
