- Ouestions:
  - Has anyone had any experiences related to unity in your groups or things that have helped them have more unity?
    - (Elmhurst IL) We got an opportunity to practice unity when we had conflict while planning a group event
    - (Rockford IL) Other group in area modeled how to let principles of the program guide us even when our natural instincts tell us to do otherwise. Even if people don't agree and have different perspectives the principles teach us to appreciate it. Unity isn't agreeing, it is accepting other people's perspectives.
    - (Delegate) Principles are the backbone of our program. Steps for personal growth, traditions for group, and concepts for service. Tradition 5 reminds us of our primary purpose. Tradition 12 reminds us to place principles above personalities. The principles can be used in all areas of life. Would like to hear suggestions or comments on what the 12 concepts of service means to them.
    - (Des Peres MO) Very happy to participate in the call and bring information back to the group. Not having a
      representative to bring information back has effected the health of her group.
