 Questions posed and comments:
- 1) Have you ever experienced a diversion from the Nar-anon program in your meeting? How did you feel?
- 2) What in your recovery has been a diversion to you?

- 4) How do you feel about this program having a primary spiritual aim? Where you aware of that when you came into the rooms?

- 6) Have you experienced the words of a fellow member popping into your mind at just the right moment?
 - Janis (Elmhurst IL) has experienced a diversion during a meeting when a newcomer comes and starts to ask questions about what they can do, which can be awkward. She shares she also experiences spiritual connection in her home group. She thinks that is the thing that attracts people to their group.
 - Dale (Chesterfield MO) In his group, regular attendees share first before the newcomers so that they can witness other members and have a better understanding of the program before they speak. They then offer to sit one on one with newcomers to comfort them and answer questions. They choose to share going around the room to foster inclusion.
 - Ruth (Delegate, attends Elmhurst IL). They once had a physician who works with addiction come and share, he spoke about how family members need to help and control etc and it turned out to be a very uncomfortable experience causing her to question having non-naranon

people participate in naranon meetings. She found this to be a diversion from the program and send a message that might not be consistent with the program.

- Ilene (Schaumburg) shares that this workshop has caused her to want to think this all through a little more and see how it relates to the health of her home group.
- Shannon (Secretary, attends Rockford IL) encourages people that the talking doesn't have to end just because the call does. The Roster is there so that GSRs can communicate in between conference calls ©
