A lot like DR's offices we need to approach the Office Manager, or Nurse in charge. It only takes a few minuets to explain Nar-Anon and to leave them with some literature. They are usually very welcoming and in need of a resource like ours. The two that we have been to, took some to place in their waiting areas but also asked for extra that they could hand out when talking with people.

It is always a special feeling when your doing outreach and the people are so welcoming to putting some of your literature out. This is a good one for beginners to outreach to do.
