Between the hotel and the Assembly:

Creve Coeur Lake: Canoe, kayak, paddleboard, and bicycle rentals (Crevecoeurlakerentals.com)
(9 minutes) Walking/running, bicycling, rollerblading, walking trail of any length desired
Go Ape zipline program (Goape.com)
Fishing

Dave & Busters and Hollywood Casino are both within short drive from the hotel (7 minutes)
Thies Farms for fresh produce and a wonderful pumpkin selection; both in the field and in store (6 minutes)

Just West of the assembly:

10 minutes from the Assembly:

Faust County Park - home to one of a few Butterfly Houses in the country, the 1904 World's Fair Carousel (available to ride) and a multi building historic village
Chesterfield Mall - an indoor shopping mall surrounded by some excellent dining options
Chesterfield Commons - the longest strip mall in the country, with over 80 restaurants
Taubman Prestige Outlet Mall
St Louis Premium Outlets Mall
Raumbach's Farm - another pumpkin farm
River's Edge Park - walking trail around a small lake
Chesterfield Sports Complex - a premier youth sports complex (hosting a major softball tournament the weekend of the Assembly)

East of the Assembly, approximately 13 to 18 miles:

St Louis Zoo - one of the premier zoos in the country -- and admission is FREE; St Louis Art Museum; Busch Memorial Stadium; St Louis Arch and new grounds; Forest Park (second largest city park in the country, only behind NYC's Central Park); InBev (formerly Anheuser Busch); Soulard Market, the Central West End, the Delmar Loop - with a brand new trip from the past trolley car, and much, MUCH more!!!
