- A. There were 60 meetings located in the Midwest Region's 5 states; Oct., 2016.
 2 meetings were added as of Oct., 2017, and thus, MWR now encompasses 6 states. There were 13 new meetings, but 11 meetings closed; more than in any other year. (Many of these were *new* meetings that closed w/in first 150 days.)

A very brief history of 12 step Recovery:

1918- Lois married the founder of Alcoholics Anonymous, Bill W.

1934- Bill had a spiritual awakening in an institution, which began "Recovery" as we it.

1936- Al-Anon was started partly by Lois W. (1951 was first Alanon WSC);

1968- Nar-anon asks permission to use Alanon's Lit, 1968.

1971- In Southern California, Nar-Anon became a legal entity which is where the World Service Organization offices came into being in 1976, and are currently located.

1972- The "3 C's" originated from Al-Anon, but were adopted by Nar-anon.

2006- First World Service Conference (WSO) of Nar-anon- this event has occurred biannually since that time- At the WSC the Midwest region gives back to Nar-anon as a whole in sending a delegate and alternate delegate who carry the voice and vote of our region. Fellowship literature is revised and conference approved. Service Literature and Service Guides are prepared and approved for the fellowship of Nar-anon.
