Judy - KS Shawnee: Alternate weeks between - Steps to yourself Traditions group/family Concepts broader world/community

Ilene - IL Schaumburg: Read Steps every meeting Tradition & Concept of month not discussed - Reading from SESH - Lamented cards

Jerry - KS Topeka: Use SESH book

Leanne - IL Vandalia: Serenity Connection - SESH - Use Traditions that have been supplied from Theresa

Joni - IL Homewood: One week SESH that day (topic can pick any) - Step for Month - Tradition of the Month (many do not want to volunteer when Tradition week)

Book & Topic have more volunteers

Dale: Traditions- Lack of understanding could be why

Maria - IL DuQuoin: Step meeting - Open read SESH current day - Open sharing - In 2 years never used a topic will bring up at next business meeting - Topic might be helpful

Dale: Shares focused on member or qualifier

Maria - IL DuQuoin: Never has selected a topic - Mix shares on addictive loved one others focus on themselves - Many cycle through - New focus on loved one - Regular focus on themselves and how 'I dealt with it' - 'Tools I am using'

Dale: Topic focus - Does it help that they focus on themselves & not my loved one

Leanne - IL Vandalia:: Definitely helps - Learn to take care of ourselves

Joni - IL Homewood: Distraught member - May not want to topic because they can not focus - Mind elsewhere

Dale: Go through SESH for topic of discussion - Can also talk about whatever ever you would like to talk about

Jerry - KS Topeka: Step Meeting - New comers do not understand what was going on - Do a mini newcomers talk - Be flexible

Don - IL Willow Springs: Big turn over 3-4 consistent members. - New comers look for quick fix & we don't have that & try to move focus to themselves - Friendly environment purpose of group - Large turn over - Dark & in the middle of neighborhood - Does location really make a difference

Kevin - IL Maryville: Started in basement of church - Moved to more central location & participation soared - Right off freeway - NA meeting in the basement Naranon is in conference room

Dale: Times & date & location - Sometimes it is is what it is - Maybe we create a 3X5 card that can be handled

Example of using Tradition in another situation outside of Naranon

Look at principles

Tradition 1: Unity & common welfare

Leanne - IL Vandalia: Hospital had renovations & the team left attitude at home & worked together

Theresa: As you live your life you then interact differently with addicted love ones & others

Tradition 5: Meetings are a safe place

Leanne - IL Vandalia: Brings her to church similar type of trust

Teresa: Conversation with a best friend - This is not for gossip

Tradition 7: Self supporting





Marilyn - IL Springfield: Try not to discuss with too many people

Theresa: Attending meetings & reading literature - People who want it not who need it - We don't know what we don't know

Dale: Careful not to stop being self suportative of oneself - I am not open for others to support - Difficult to break in - The whole thing starts to unravel - Without them we begin to unravel - Not in Traditions it is guidance

Judy - KS Shawnee: Relationship for parenting - Non-addictive son - Help him to be accountable

Tradition 9: Every member is responsible for care of group - Inter-relationship between FHG/Region/World

Theresa: What happens at work if we don't do our job? Trusted servants at our job. There to faithfully to do their part.

Dale: Replace house windows & did not fit. Turned out too much chalk was used & low paid worker caused the ripple effect

Tradition 10: No opinion on outside controversy

Maria - IL DuQuoin: My extended family - Get together- Politics needs to stay out of it - Purpose to be there for the family

Tradition 11: Outreach on attraction not promotion

Theresa: You have the right to protect your boundaries - Stepping out of conversation - Do not need to participate

Tradition 12: Spiritual foundation is anonymity

Thersa: As parents we have to explain why we do certain things - Not required to explain our actions or reactions to anyone - You have rights as an individual person Joni - IL Homewood: Taking & applying to real life

Theresa: Looking at principles behind Traditions - Work in day to day life- Might be helpful to clarify with addictive loved one

Jerry - KS Topeka: Anonymity - Our qualifier should have anonymity do not share with others - Personal struggles are theirs

Theresa: Get to this as we get further into the program
