**Tradition 4:** 

Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other Nar-Anon Family Groups, or NA as a whole.\*

#### Family Home Group

As a worldwide fellowship we strive to maintain the integrity of Nar-Anon by not diluting the program. As far as NA and Nar-Anon; we are not affiliated. Tradition Four reminds us that each fellowship is a separate entity with separate autonomy. We are not involved in each other's business. Our fellowships do respect each other in the spirit of cooperation\*

Study Question as it pertains to FHG:

In what ways could decisions of our group negatively affect another NFG or NA?\* What are some examples of Nar-Anon and NA working in the spirit of cooperation?\* How can my personal behavior or actions affect another FHG or NA?\* What would you expect to be similar when attending another group?\*

## **Family**

Tradition Four is conditional. We can practice autonomy when our actions do not negatively affect others, our family unity and welfare. We can ask ourselves how we would want to be treated as well as examine our motives. In our relationships, it is not just about me but the good of the order.\*

> <u>Study Question as it pertains to Family:</u> What spiritual principles in Tradition Four help me in relationships: family, work, other relationships?\*

> > **Service**

Groups have autonomy; service committees do not. Committees and the body they serve practice regular two way communication and reporting in order to best come to responsible decisions reflecting the Nar-Anon family groups.\*

#### Study Ouestion as it pertains to Service: What are examples of service committees? Why do they not have autonomy? Do we change the people in our service positions, locally and regionally as recommended?\*\*
