 - ii. Removal of RSC Officers RSC officers may be removed from their positions after written notification of noncompliance. A two-thirds (2/3) majority of the voting assembly members is required for removal of any RSC officer. Non-compliance includes, but is not limited to, failure to fulfill the duties of their positions, and failure to attend two (2) consecutive regular RSC meetings without prior notification to the chair. It is within the discretion of the RSC to accept a written report in lieu of attendance. If removals or resignations occur during an RSC meeting, that position shall be filled on an interim basis at that time. If removals or resignations occur between regularly scheduled RSC meetings, the chair will call an interim assembly for a special election to fill the position until the next election assembly.'
