Page 4-1 to 4-6 Group Structure

- 1. How does your FHG elect officers & how often are service positions rotated?
- 2. What officers are listed in GLS? Can you list them along with a few duties of each?
 - a. Does your FHG have these positions filled?
 - b. Does your FHG have other officers/positions? Explain
- 3. How might your group 'share the Chair' so all members can take turns leading a meeting?
- 4. Group Service Representative (GSR)
 - a. How long have you served in this position? Does this align with guidelines in GLS?
 - b. How can understanding the Twelve Traditions & Twelve Concepts help serve as a GSR?
- 5. How can the GSR and Secretary share in 2 way communication between group members and other levels of the service structure?
- 6. How does your treasurer keep track of the group's expenses and donations? How often do you report to your FHG? How often does your FHG donate up?
- 7. Now that the GSR is becoming familiar with the GLS and GWS, how are you sharing the information with your FHG?
- 8. Has your FHG ever used the agenda for Group Conscious?
 - a. Yes/No?
 - b. If not, does your group perform Group Conscious in another way?
 - c. Why is it advantageous for all members to have the Group Conscience agenda announced several weeks in advance?
- 9. Can one take a service position in multiple groups?
 - a. Although we may choose to attend various group meetings, why do we declare one our 'home group'?
- 10. What is Dual-Membership?
 - a. What service positions can these members hold & not hold?
- 11. How does 'Our Common Welfare' (Tradition One) come into play in regards to the outcome of a Group Conscience?

- 12. How can we take the process used in Group Conscious within our meetings out into our life?
- 13. How does your group balance their autonomy while keeping aligned with Nar-Anon guidelines?
- 14. Who has the ability to close a group?
 - a. How do we follow Tradition 4 in regards to possibly removing a group from a directory, meeting list and/or website?
